

BOCCIA GAME RULES



KID'S CONCEPT
SWEDISH DESIGN



Boccia can be played individually or in teams.

The game begins with one player throwing the small target ball (Jack) onto the court. They follow up with their coloured ball getting as close to Jack as possible. The object is to get as close to Jack as possible. The opponent then throws trying to get closer to Jack. The player or team that is not closest to the Jack must then throw until they put a ball closer to the Jack. This order of play continues until all balls are thrown. Players can knock balls out of the way in order to become closest. They can push their own ball in closer to the Jack.

When all balls have been thrown, a referee determines the points awarded for that end. The colour that is closest to the Jack receives the number of points equal to the number of balls that they have closer to the jack than their opponent's closest ball. Play one round, or play until a set point. **Let's play!**
